


Alief ISD Staff, Drivers and Attendants:

The Texas legislature recently passed House Bill 3834. HB3834 requires that all district employees that have access to district computers or district databases must take a TEA approved cybersecurity awareness training course. Employees with district *aliefisd.net* email addresses will receive an email with login instructions to access the online cybersecurity awareness course. The welcome email you will receive will be sent from system@litmos.com and will be Alief ISD branded. A sample screenshot of the welcome email is shown below. This course will take approximately 30 minutes to complete. **All staff are required to complete the course by December 1, 2020.** Your partnership in helping Alief ISD satisfy this mandate is critical. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Also, the course is best taken on a laptop, desktop or mac using the latest version of the Chrome browser. The vendor does not recommend attempting the course on a cell phone or similar sized device. Finally, the vendor recommends that users take the course with a browser in full-screen so that they can see all the controls and links on the training pages

Step 1

To access district email, you must log in through Alief HUB. You will need your district issued username and the password you created.


If you forgot your username or password, you can call tech support at 281-498-8110 ext. 22530 for assistance.






