General Description

Under direction of the Children Interacting Afterschool Site Leader/Coordinator and CIA District Coordinator. Responsible for the implementation of CIA educational, recreational, and/or enrichment curriculum. Provides safety and security while engaging students in developmentally appropriate activities.

Qualifications

- Minimum two years of college experience.
- Previous experience working with school-age children.
- Willingness to learn.
- Ability to maintain discipline, motivate students, and communicate effectively with students.
- Ability to write and implement high quality hands-on, effective and fun academic and enrichment lessons.

Responsibilities

- Monitors student safety and security.
- Writes and submits fun, hands-on, engaging, age-appropriate lessons plans for academic/enrichment classes.
- Assists with implementation of academic, enrichment and recreational curriculum/programs.
- Maintains open communications with parents, school administration and staff.
- Communicates program expectations and rules clearly, effectively and in a positive manner with students.
- Knowledgeable about program policy and procedure to respond appropriately to parent inquiries and concerns.
- Implements positive behavior management techniques with students.
- Actively participates in activities with students; not just supervising or observing.
- Establishes a positive, supportive and working relationship with supervisor(s) and teammates.
- Participates in training to improve effectiveness with students and improve program quality.
- Demonstrates responsible control over assigned program resources.
- Monitors CIA facility maintenance and cleanliness.
- Must be on time to assigned program site and find approved substitute for absences.
- Maintains accurate daily student attendance.
- Must have, or be able to attend, scheduled CPR and First Aid Certification.
- Must be exempt from or obtain 8 hours of pre-service training within established deadlines.
- Must obtain 15 hours of training in specified child development areas within established deadlines.
- Must be able to lift 30 to 35 pounds.
- Performs other duties as assigned. Occasional evening activities.



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Terms of Employment

- Salary:
 - Certified teachers - \$25/hour
 - Bachelor's degree professionals - \$20/hour
 - Non-certified/non-degreed or Associates degree: \$15/hour
 - College Student: \$13/hour
- Position will be approximately 2–15 hours per week
- Position is filled only after required student enrollment is met
- Required staff training – dates provided upon hiring
