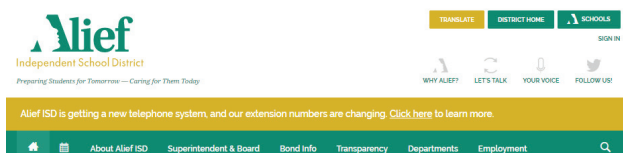


District & School Website

HOW TO ACCESS THE WEBSITE: Visit www.aliefisd.net from your device. Look for the Schools button to visit campus websites.

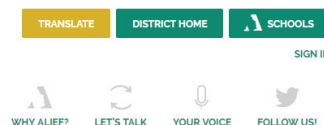


Let's Talk!

Home Access Center
