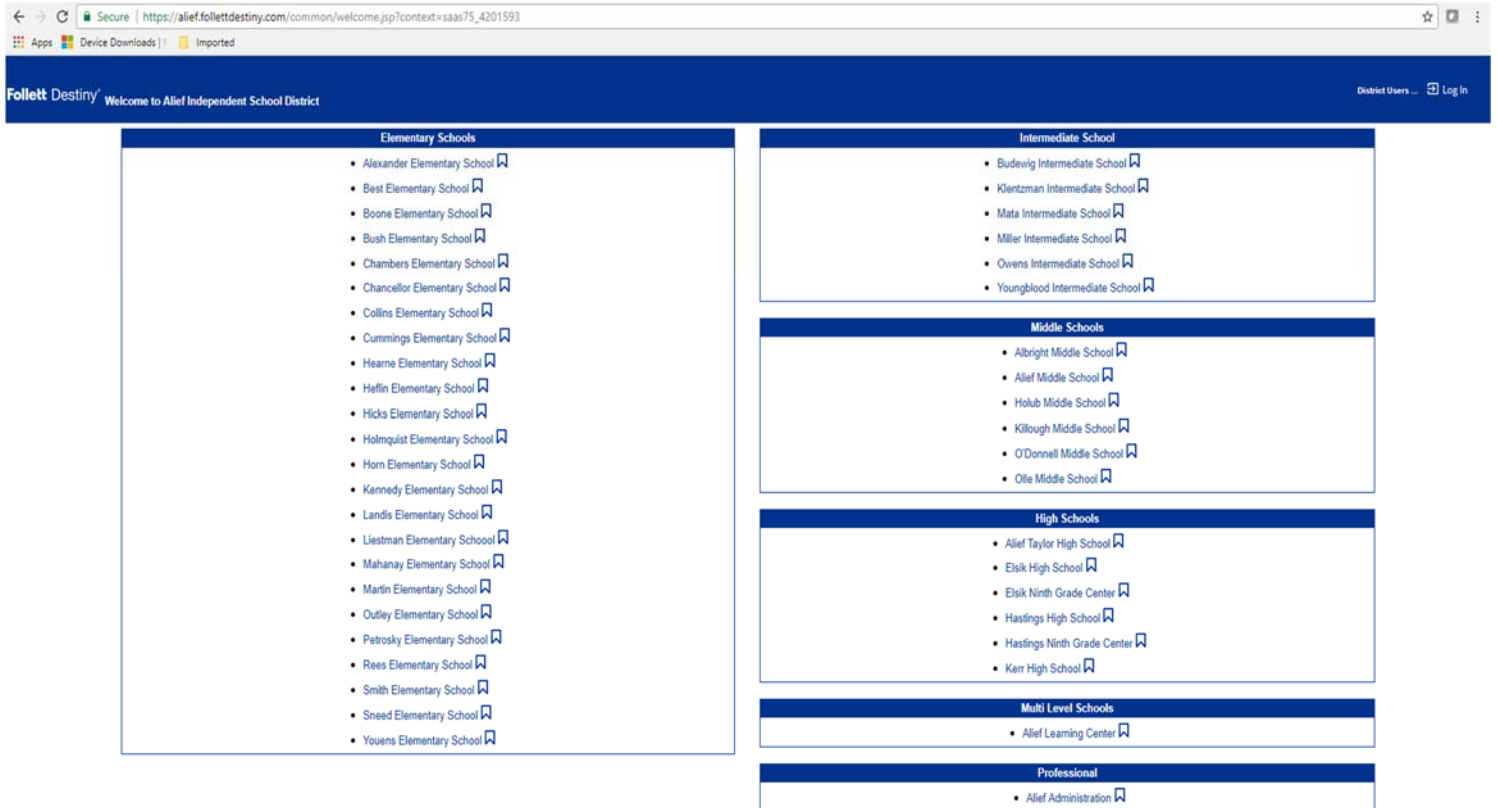
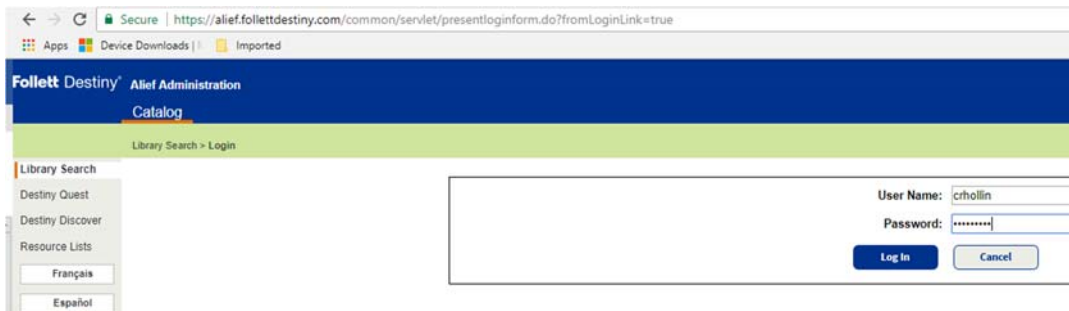


Accessing Destiny Discover

Staff Usernames and passwords:

- Destiny Staff Username: network username
- Destiny Staff Password: F and staff number and first letter of first name and first letter of last name

Example:

- Staff Name: Deijah J Stone
- Staff Number: 123456
- Destiny Staff Username: djstone
- Destiny Staff Password: F123456DS

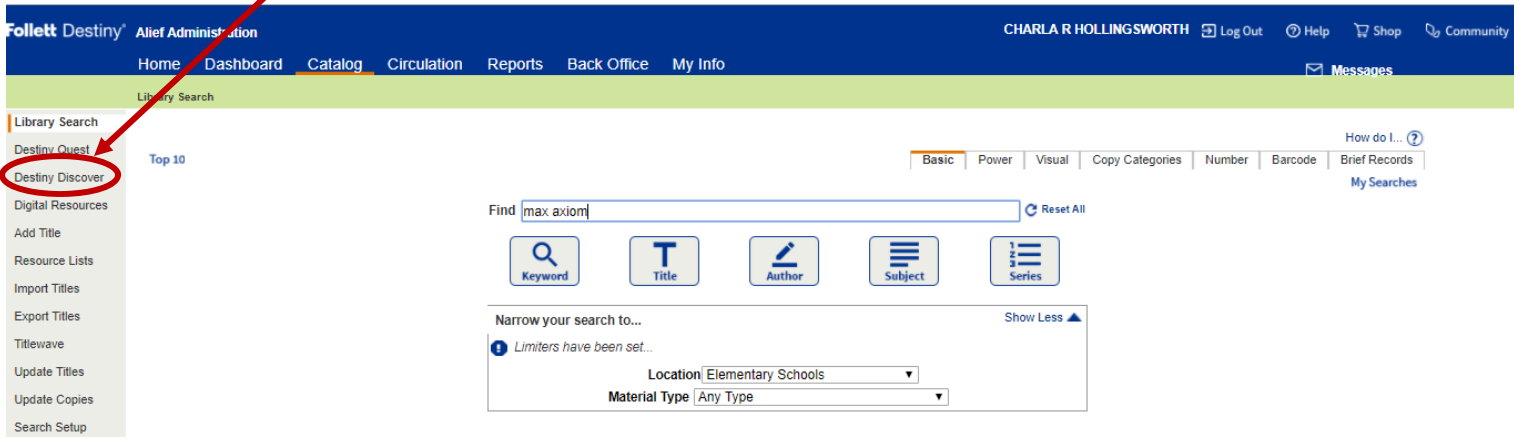
Student Usernames and passwords:

- Destiny Student Username: ID number
- Destiny Student Password: ID number and first letter of first name and first letter of last name

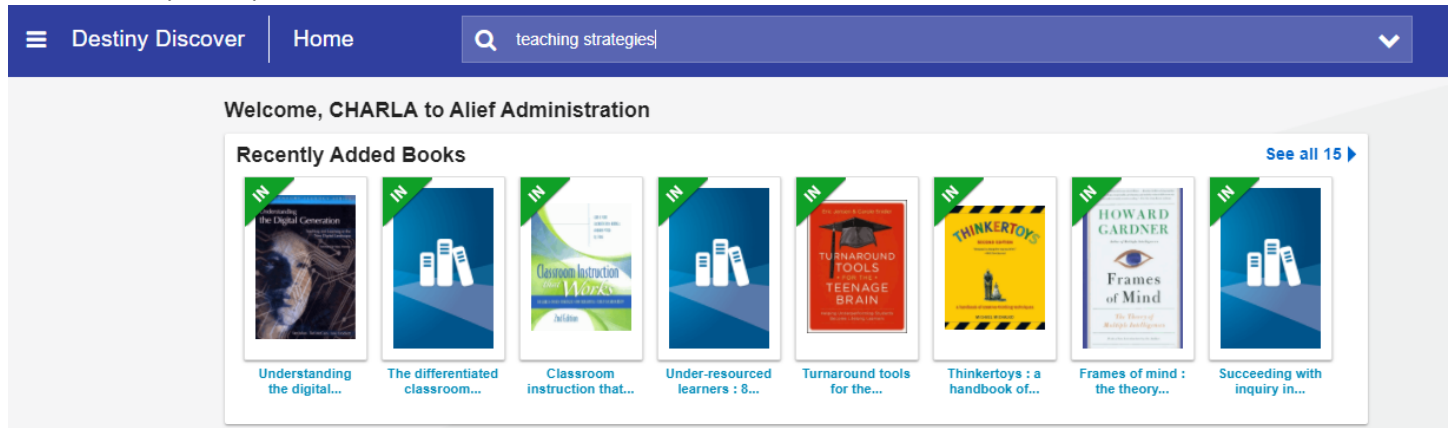
Example:

- Destiny Student Password: 123456DS

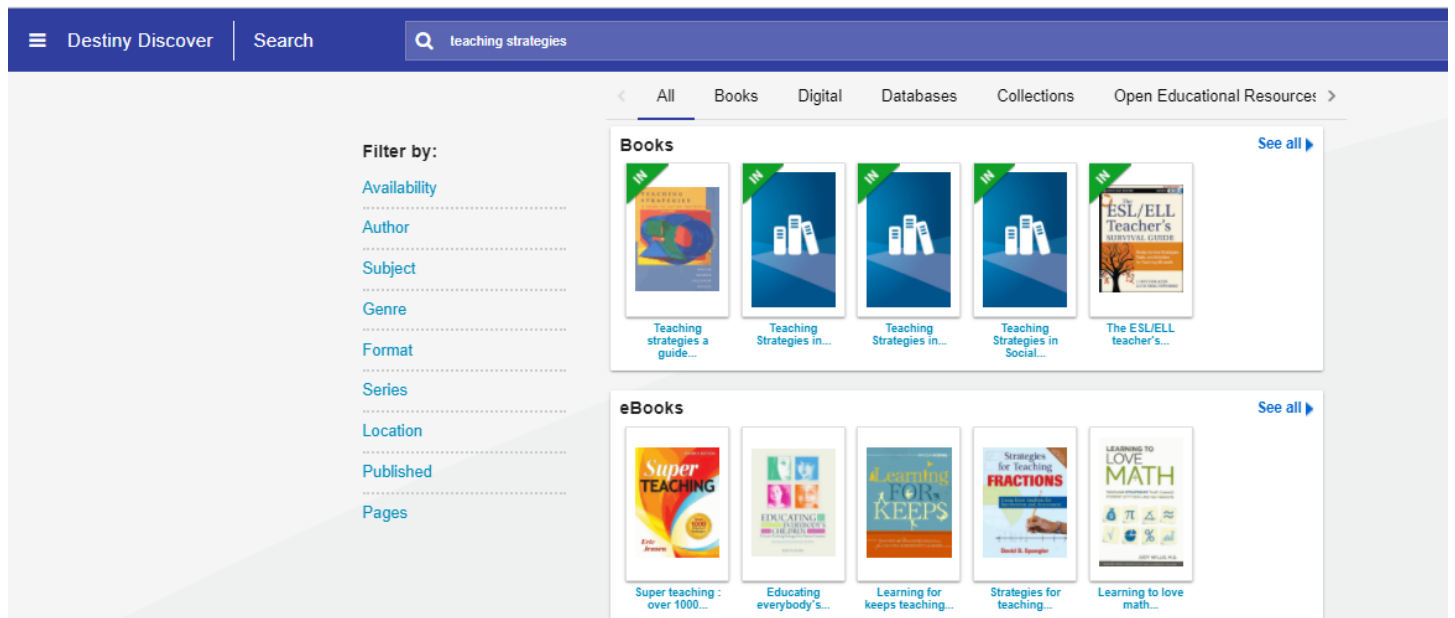
