IN-DISTRICT Transfers
Frequently Asked Questions

What is an In-District Transfer?
If you live in the Alief ISD school district, a parent/guardian to a student may request to change the student's school to another Alief ISD school.
Is there an application fee for in-district transfers?
No.
Will district transportation be provided for my child?
No. Parents of children who are approved to attend a school they are not zoned to are responsible for transporting their children to and from the approved school.
Where can I get an In-District Transfer application form?
There are no paper application forms. The In-District Transfer application is available on the district website (www.aliefisd.net/enroll) Please select 'Transfers' and go to the In-District Transfer application link.
Which grade levels are eligible for an In-District Transfer?
Applications are being accepted for students in grades Pre-Kindergarten – 12 th Grade.
My child was assigned to a high school different from the one where my other children graduated from or attends now. May I apply for a different high school using this form?
Yes.
Which schools are not accepting students to attend with an In-District Transfer?
Currently, the following schools are capped due to student numbers and WILL NOT BE ACCEPTING students through the In-District Transfer program. Elementary School: Sneed Intermediate School: Budewig Middle School: O'Donnell High Schools: AECHS, Kerr, and Taylor
What factors will be reviewed for an In-District Transfer approval?
Attendance, discipline, academic success, and availability of campus space requested will be reviewed. A student who has had excessive tardies, absences, and/or discipline referrals will not be approved for a transfer.
When will I know if my child's application for enrollment has been accepted?
Parents/Guardians of applicants will receive an email of approval or denial. If approved, the email will specify the campus assignment and directions for enrolling the child at the approved campus.
I have more than one child that I would like to transfer to a different campus. Do I have to submit a separate application for each child?
Yes. An application is required for each student. This is required because each student is applying for a specific empty seat, in a specific grade, at a specific campus. Each application is reviewed separately.
My child participates in University Interscholastic League (UIL) activities at his/her current school. Will he/she be eligible to continue participating at the new school?
Students <u>will not be eligible</u> for competitive activities for one (1) calendar year after the approval of an In-District Transfer in Alief ISD.
What if a student who transfer repeatedly violates district rules?
Board Policy (FDB Local) states that the student must follow all rules and regulations of the district, including but not limited to, Alief ISD policies and regulations, the Student Code of Conduct, and attendance requirements. Violations of the terms of agreement may result in a transfer being revoked.
Is a student transferring as a junior or senior year eligible for recognition as valedictorian or salutatorian?
In order for a student to be recognized as valedictorian or salutatorian in Alief, the student must have been continuously enrolled in the same high school in the district for the four semesters immediately preceding graduation (AISD Board Policy EIC Local).
