WHEREAS, the Alief ISD Board of Trustees is committed to the success of every child; and,

WHEREAS, HB 1842 provides Texas public school districts the opportunity to be designated as Districts of Innovation; and,

WHEREAS, Texas districts designated as Districts of Innovation may be exempted from a number of state statutes; and,

WHEREAS, the Alief ISD Board of Trustees has a long-standing practice of supporting innovation for the benefit of students; and,

WHEREAS, the Alief ISD Board of Trustees believes that it can be a better decision-making body for students when it has freedom to exercise local control over the decision-making process; and,

WHEREAS, HB 1842 requires districts seeking to be designated as Districts of Innovation to develop a local innovation plan; and,

WHEREAS, before considering the creation of a local innovation plan, the Alief ISD Board of Trustees will hold a public hearing to receive feedback from District stakeholders.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Alief ISD Board of Trustees on March 22, 2016, initiates the process of exploring and considering designation of the District as a District of Innovation under HB 1842.


