

## **OUTLEY MODE OF DRESS . . .**

**Colors:** Tops – red, white or blue (Solid Colors)  
Bottoms – navy, khaki or jeans

**Styles:** Solid color that is plain without any emblems or writing and must have a collar and sleeves.



- Shirts are tucked at the waist
- Bottoms are fitted (not baggy) and worn at the waist
- Sweat or athletic style pants inappropriate for school wear
- Belts are worn if the garment has belt loops
- Shorts, slacks, skirts, and skorts are acceptable
- Girls may wear jumper dresses
- If shorts or skirts are too short (not near the knee in length), parents will be called to bring proper attire.

### **Accessories:**

- Sweaters/jackets are solid red, navy or white.
- Cardigans, pullovers, or v-neck styles are acceptable if worn with solid red, white or blue colored shirts underneath.
- Sweatshirts are also solid red, white or blue and of lengths near the waist (not near the knee).
- A solid white t-shirt with no writing may be worn under any collared shirt.
- Athletic shoes are suggested for safety purposes.
