- 1) Reviewed & approved September meeting minutes
 - Minutes approved from September meeting by committee vote.
 - 2) Discussed list of suggested Professional Development opportunities for campus and district.
 - Ms. Elzy has been developing a cumulative list of all PD activities and sessions that have occurred to all staff throughout this past summer and beginning of the 2019-20 school year, as well as future offerings.
 - Ms. Chacko mentioned several and asked for members' suggestions emailed or written to Ms. Elzy. Ms. Chacko also mentioned future sessions in November and December for all staff that are state mandated as well as Alief ISD mandated.
 - 3) Discussed a plan of action regarding major components of CIP to share with all staff in November.
 - Ms. Stroud explained the parts and the goals of the CIP.

- Parent representative expressed community concern for student/staff safety and traffic safety, after a recent accident involving an Alief ISD employee and an Alief ISD student. -Ms. Chacko responded to concern mentioning increased police presence and traffic control modifications that Alief ISD Police will be implementing immediately.
- Parent rep also mentioned campus restroom facilities being unsanitary and unsafe, mentioning lack of locks/latches in facilities. -Campus custodial and maintenance staff have been alerted of those concerns.
