

Chancellor Elementary School Anti-Bullying Policy Summary

Chancellor Elementary School is committed to providing students with a safe and supportive learning environment. We do not condone intimidation or bullying of any kind.

Bullying is when a person or persons use **power** to **deliberately hurt** another or their property or **repeatedly frighten** a person and interferes with that student's education or the operation of the school. Bullying may be physical, verbal, emotional or cyberbullying.

Chancellor Elementary School expects students to treat each other with respect.

Chancellor Elementary School employees are required to report suspected violations of this policy to their supervisor. Students, parents and visitors may also report any act that may be a violation of this policy. Reports will be investigated.

Chancellor Elementary School has developed a set of consequences that matches disciplinary and/or remedial actions to specific unacceptable behaviors.
