Dress Code Policy

- ▶ 7th Grade
 - ▶ White or Gray collared shirts
- ▶ 8th Grade
 - ▶ Red or Navy Blue collared shirts
- ▶ College Shirts on Wednesdays
- ▶ Club/Spirit Shirts Fridays
- ▶ STEM students may wear shirts on STEMtastic Day or Friday

- ▶ Pants
 - ▶ Khaki or Navy uniform style pants
 - ▶ No holes, rips, or tears
 - ▶ No jeans
 - ▶ Skirts and shorts cannot be higher than two inches above the knee

Dress Code Policy

- ▶ Sweatshirts, Jackets, Cardigans, etc.
 - ▶ 7th Grade - White or Gray
 - ▶ 8th Grade - Blue or Red
 - ▶ Button Down shirts are not allowed
- ▶ T-Shirts and Hoodies can be purchased from Ms. Anderson starting Monday, August 28th

Dress Code Policy

▶ Not Allowed

- ▶ Hair color must be a natural color that can grow from your scalp (no pink, green, blue, purple, rainbow, etc. are allowed)
- ▶ PE Shirts
- ▶ Jeans
- ▶ Button Down Shirts
- ▶ Flip Flops, Slides, Sandals, etc.
- ▶ Headbands (boys and girls cannot wear bandanas as headbands)
- ▶ Ear Piercings (boys)
- ▶ Facial Piercings (everyone)
- ▶ Facial Hair
- ▶ Inappropriate References to drugs, weapons, profanity, etc.

Dress Code Policy

- ▶ Students who violate dress code....
 - ▶ Asked to change in CIS
 - ▶ Sweatshirts, headbands, earrings, etc. will be confiscated.
 - ▶ Returned at the end of the day
 - ▶ Repeat offenders will be kept until a parent comes to retrieve the item
 - ▶ Students will be placed in SAC until a change of clothes is brought for them.

Cell Phone Policy

- ▶ Cell phones and electronic devices must be out of sight unless they are being used for instructional purposes
- ▶ Devices will be confiscated if you violate expectations:
 - ▶ 1st time: Warning; Returned to student at the end of the day
 - ▶ 2nd time: \$15 fee- returned to student
 - ▶ 3rd time: \$15 fee- returned to parent
- ▶ If a staff member asks you to turn in your phone, turn it in.
 - ▶ If you refuse to turn in your cell phone, it will be confiscated and returned only to your parent/guardian.
 - ▶ You may face further consequences including suspension.

Cafeteria Policy

- ▶ Enter the cafeteria with your teacher
- ▶ Sit at your teacher's table
- ▶ Wait to be dismissed to the lunch line
- ▶ Go through the snack line at the same time you go through the lunch line
- ▶ Raise your hand for a restroom pass
- ▶ Wait for a trash can to come to you
- ▶ Do not throw food
- ▶ If you violate these rules, you will receive lunch detention

Arrival and Dismissal

▶ Arrival

- ▶ Stay outside of the red doors until 8:00
- ▶ When you arrive on campus, come to the gym or the cafeteria.
- ▶ Do not wait for your friends in the courtyard or by the portables

▶ Dismissal

- ▶ Wait for your transportation to be called
- ▶ If you come outside before your bus is called, you will walk home or wait for the 5:15 bus
- ▶ Do not hang out by the bowling alley. Police will be called.
- ▶ Do not hang out at the Boone playground. Police will be called.
- ▶ Go home.
- ▶ If you leave campus, you cannot return and get on a late bus
- ▶ To ride a late bus, you must have a pass.

Building Safety

- ▶ Do not open the doors for anyone.
- ▶ All visitors must come in through the front door
- ▶ If you see someone trying to get in, find an adult to address them.

Basketball / Volleyball

- ▶ If you would like to stay for a game after school, you must have a parent with you.
- ▶ You must have your permanent ID.
- ▶ You must leave and come back with a parent.

Conflicts

- ▶ Verbal Altercation
 - ▶ 1st Offense - SAC or Suspension
 - ▶ 2nd Offense - Suspension and CLC
 - ▶ 3rd Offense - ALC
- ▶ Physical Altercation
 - ▶ 1st Offense - CLC
 - ▶ 2nd Offense - ALC
 - ▶ This includes slapboxing... if it looks like a fight, it will be treated like one.
- ▶ Gang Related Activity
 - ▶ Any gang related offense may result in automatic CLC or ALC
- ▶ Come to the counselor or AP if you are having problems with another student.

Self Harm

- ▶ If you believe someone is or might be harming themselves, come to a counselor or AP immediately
- ▶ Everything shared in the counselor or AP office is confidential.

Bullying

- ▶ Bullying of any kind is taken very seriously and will not be tolerated.
- ▶ Bullying includes physical, emotional, and cyber offenses.
- ▶ If you are being bullied or know of someone that is being bullied, talk to a teacher, counselor, or administrator.
