ACADEMIC COURSES

Students may take Reading, History, Science, Math, or English Language Arts classes.

SPECIAL EDUCATION / 504

Academic adaptations for Special Education or 504 students attending Summer School will be provided to all summer school coordinators and staff.

GRADING

Students must earn at least a grade of 70 in each class.

PROGRESS REPORT

Progress reports will be distributed on **June 13**.
Report cards will be distributed on **June 27**.

ATTENDANCE

The student must attend at least 90% (14 days) of the program.

TARDIES

Two tardies of less than 15 minutes equal one absence. Arrival to class 15 minutes late equals one absence.

DRESS CODE POLICY

7th grade, white or navy polo style shirts and khaki/blue pants, shorts.
8th grade dress code will be discussed in detail at the parent meeting.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

Two level 1 offenses in the classroom or on transportation may result in the loss of summer school credit. One referral on the bus will result in loss of transportation privileges. Severe misbehavior such as level 2 & 3 offenses may result in the loss of summer school credit. Students dismissed from the Summer School Program may be retained.

TRANSPORTATION

Bus transportation will be provided to eligible riders at a designated bus stop. Please speak to the coordinator from your school as to the location of this stop and the pick-up time.

BREAKFAST AND LUNCH

Free breakfast and lunch will be provided daily.
