

Grading Policy for ENGC

Major (50%) – not limited to:

- **Tests** → CCAs, DCAs, and Unit Tests
- **Projects** → Long (week or more), can be presentations or independently

Minor (35%) – not limited to:

- Quizzes → subject, notebook (quick check)
- In-Depth Classwork → graded for accuracy
- Team/Group Activities

Other (15%) – not limited to:

- Completion grades
- Homework
- Remediation
- Warm-ups
- Small in-class activities
- Exit Cards/Tickets
- Short Quizzes

Absences/Make-up Work

If a student has missed work and his/her absence is not due to truancy, the teacher will make every effort to give the student the opportunity to make up the work. It is the student's responsibility to arrange a make-up schedule upon his/her return to school. The teacher will schedule the time. If a test was scheduled before the student was absent, then the student may be required to take the test the day he/she returns. If a student is absent several days in a row, the student should make arrangements convenient for the teacher. Missed work or tests should be made up before or after school, not during class time.

Students will have the number of days absent, plus one to turn in any work missed. For example, if a student misses two days of class, he or she will have three days to make up missed assignments.

Retesting

Students receiving a grade less than a 70 on a major assignment will have the opportunity to retest.
