Missed Work

Daily attendance is *required*. If a student is absent, the student will need to make up missed work. **Students are expected to attend all 7 assigned classes as scheduled every school day-** just as if you were coming to campus in person.

Virtual Learning Expectations

Show Respect- Adhere to the rules and expectations set forth by your teachers and do not disrupt the learning environment of others.

Code of Civility- While in the virtual learning environment, continue to show consideration and respect to others. It is not acceptable to use obscene, profane, threatening, or disrespectful language.

Dress Appropriately- Clothing should follow the standard of dress as listed in the student handbook. You must have on an appropriate top and bottom.

Limit Distractions- All phones should be muted. Do not eat and drink while class is in session.

Virtual Learning Expectations

Live Sessions- When students are attending a live session, they must mute their microphone so no one student's background noise interferes with instruction (remember there are going to be MANY students in each class online at the same time).

Communication- Written or verbal dialogue within the virtual classroom will be appropriate grade level language; “text language” is unacceptable. Any form of profanity/vulgarity is prohibited. (This extends to emails, discussion postings, group projects, and submitted assignments in all learning platforms).

ZOOM Participation Expectations

- Arrive on time for the class session. You will be admitted to the “waiting room” before being admitted to the class.
- The name displayed in the ZOOM setting should be your first and last name only. Changing your name to something inappropriate is unacceptable behavior and will be addressed immediately.
- Posture before the camera must be conducive to active learning and participation (e.g., no reclining). The student’s full face must be visible in the camera frame.
- Taking screenshots or screen recordings of virtual classrooms without the explicit permission from the teacher and class members is unacceptable.
