Exams are 2hrs 15 minutes except the 7th period final on Tuesday which is a 2hr 5 min. final exam.

Semester Exam Exemptions:

Students pick up forms from AP's office on **December 3rd-7th**.

According to the instructions, students may choose which final or finals they wish to be exempt.

Maximum allowed:

- **9th Grade:** Fall- 0 exemptions/Spring - 2 exemptions
- **10th Grade:** 2 exemptions per semester
- **11th Grade:** 3 exemptions per semester
- **12th Grade:** Fall – 4 exemptions/Spring – All Classes

- ❖ **No exemptions in core classes** in the fall for 10th through 11th grade students
- ❖ **Remediation classes** cannot be exempted

Eligibility:

- No more than two (2) absences (excused or unexcused) or two (2) tardies in the class from which exemption is requested.
- Truancy in any class will disqualify a student from any exemption.
- Absences for school business do not count against a student.
- No more than a total of 2 discipline referrals for semester
- No SAC (periods or all day), suspension, CLC, or emergency removals from school for disciplinary reasons.
- A grade of 85 or better; 80 in Pre/AP for the semester in the class or classes in which the exemption is requested.
- A conduct grade of satisfactory or excellent in all classes.
- **Clear of all debts**

Transfer students have the responsibility to provide attendance and disciplinary information from the previous school to be considered for exemptions.

Any student who qualifies for an exemption has the option to take final exams. The grade received on the exam is weighted at 20% of the semester grade. The numerical average for the two nine-week periods will be their semester grade if the student is exempt and does not take a final.

Students are responsible for turning in the form to their Assistant Principal's office by Dec. 7th @ 3:00p.m.
