



Kennedy Elementary School: Phase-In Family Support Information

We are so excited to begin safe in-person learning with your child. We have been hard at work preparing our classrooms, training our staff, and ensuring that we can provide a healthy, productive, and engaged learning experience for our students. We know that in-person instruction will look different than it ever has before. To that end, we are providing information on what to expect so that your child can be fully prepared for his/her first day back on campus.

- **On Day 1, Your Child Can Expect:**

- To receive clear directions on handwashing, hand sanitizing, distancing, mask-wearing, and other safety procedures.
- Potentially, an adjusted schedule and/or classroom space in order to ensure in-person learning is as safe as possible.
- Clear communication home from his/her school and teacher, especially if a COVID case arises on campus.



- **Each Day, Your Child Should Bring:**

- The device (Chromebook, laptop, or tablet) he/she has been using for remote learning
- A personal refillable water bottle (water fountains will not be functional for safety reasons.)
- A personal face mask (must be worn daily)

- **Screen Your Child Before School Each Day for the Following Symptoms:**

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| ○ Temperature of 100 degrees or higher | ○ Headache |
| ○ Cough | ○ Vomiting |
| ○ Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing | ○ Loss of taste or smell |
| ○ Sore throat | ○ Chills |
| ○ Muscle pain/fatigue | ○ Diarrhea |



Do not send your child to a district facility if he/she has been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past 14 days, exposed to COVID-19, OR exhibits symptoms. Please call the school. This will ensure everyone in our AISD community stays safe. Your child can still be counted present by logging into Alief Learns at Home and participating virtually.

- **Exposure includes:**

- Living with someone who is confirmed positive for COVID-19
- In contact with an individual that is confirmed positive for COVID-19
- Currently waiting on COVID-19 test results
