School Supplies:

The following is a list of basic school supplies student will need. Additional needed supplies for specific classes will be given to students on the first week of school.

- 3- inch durable binder
- 3- hole homework folder with pockets
- Pens
- Pencil pouch that goes in the binder

- 2 packs of dividers
- 5 Composition Notebooks

Transportation:

Bus schedule will be mailed to all students eligible for transportation. This information will come directly from district building end of July or early August.

Bus tags: Students are required to wear their bus tag that was issued last school year, if bus tag is lost, student will be required to purchase a new one for \$5.00. Please direct concerns and questions regarding transportation to the district transportation department at 281- 983-8400.

Students who normally ride the bus and participating in after school activities, tutorials, or athletics will be given the opportunity to ride one of the late buses home. Late buses have limited routes; therefore, students may not be dropped off at their normal stop.

Meals:

Breakfast is available each day from 8:00am to 8:30 AM. Breakfast is free and tray lunch will be \$1.00. Students may also purchase ala carte items or bring lunch from home. Applications for families to apply for the federal school lunch program are located in the cafeteria or registrar office or you may apply on line if you have computer access. A new free lunch application is required each school year. Please send lunch form home or money until application is processed and approved. All parents are encouraged to complete an application to determine eligibility for free lunch.

Mode of dress:

Students are required to be in compliance with the mode of dress from the first day of school and throughout the remainder of the year. This includes wearing a student ID cards at school and on the bus. Students will receive an ID at the beginning of year. If an ID is lost, student will need to pay \$5.00 for every additional ID.

Cotton knit polo shirts with collar are acceptable in solid black, solid white, solid yellow, or solid blue. Satin, polyester, silk, or sheer shirts are not permitted.

Organizational T-shirts, College T-shirts, and school spirit shirts approved by administration are acceptable to wear.

Slacks, pants, and shorts:

Cotton slacks, pants, shorts and loose fitted capris pants are acceptable in solid khaki, solid black, and solid navy blue. They must fit properly and hemmed. Walking shorts must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
