SAFETY STRATEGY INTRODUCED IN ALIEF 17-18 RESTORATIVE PRACTICES (RDP)

Restorative Discipline-Marilyn Armour, Ph.D. defines restorative discipline as a relational approach to building school climate and addressing student behavior. The approach fosters **belonging** over exclusion, **social engagement** over control, and **meaningful accountability** over punishment.

Restorative Discipline Practices (RDP) in Texas began in the Fall of 2015. The Texas Education Agency partnered with the Institute for Restorative Justice and Restorative Dialogue at The University of Texas at Austin School of Social Work to participate in a statewide roll out.

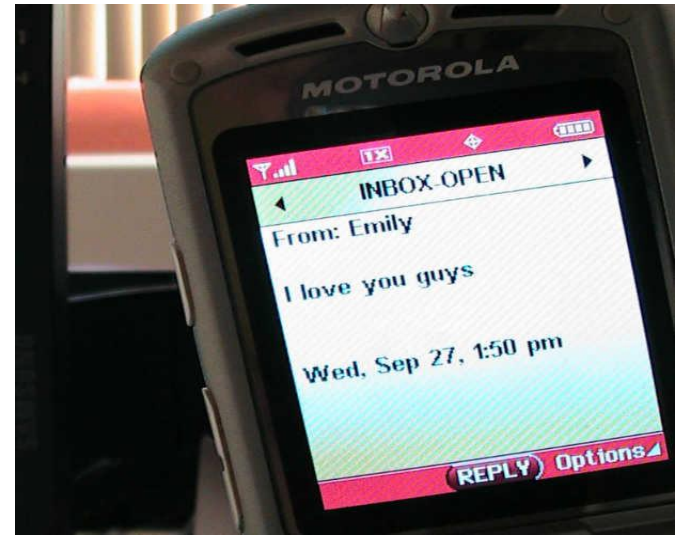

On September 27th, 2006 a gunman entered Platte Canyon High School, held seven girls hostage and ultimately shot and killed Emily Keyes. During the time she was held hostage, Emily sent her parents these text messages: "I love you guys" and "I love u guys. k?"
