Family Engagement (continued)

- Parents' Right to Know
 - ✓ Information regarding the professional qualifications of classroom teachers and/or paraprofessionals
 - ✓ Notification if student has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who does not meet the applicable state certification requirements
 - ✓ Information about student's achievement
 - ✓ Information about programs, meetings, & activities
